LIGUE EUROPÉENNE DE NATATION

- Founded 30 August 1927 in Bologna (ITA) by 10 Federations
- First European Championships in August 1926 held in Budapest (HUN).



- Objectives of LEN 1926:
- Fix the dates and events for the European Swimming, Diving and Water Polo Championships
- Fix dates and venues of international water polo tournaments
- Pass European Records
- Promote any movements for the benefit of European Swimming



• Objectives of LEN 2008 (European Aquatics):

- Organise the best running sporting events in Europe....
- Offer competitive aquatics without boundearies political, religious or social
- Work as advocates of good practice in the aquatics
- Reach everyone and every nation in Europe through the aquatics and work with FINA in building success in World aquatics
- Facilitate success for European Countries in World Championships
 and Olympic Games
- Assist Member Federations in aquatics sports development.



- Organisation of LEN:
- **Congress** (every year mandatory Congress every four years)
- Only proposals for Constitution goes to the Congress. All other rules are decided by the LEN Bureau to be presented at the next Congress.
- Calendar Meeting every year
- LEN Bureau (3 4 meeting a year)
- Standing Committees
- Audit Committee Legal Commission Marketing Commission Panel for Disciplinary Matters & Disputes – Press Commission – Award Commission
