


## Physical Education and a Sustainable Society"



*I3PE Intensive program* will be held at University of Oradea, Romania, between the 15<sup>th</sup> October and the 25<sup>th</sup> of October 2012. The participants will arrive on the 14th and leave on the 26th of October.

The IP is a fantastic opportunity to make new friends in an another social environment, to be involved in multicultural activities and get a European perspective on Physical Education.

This IP means a special cooperation between 11 European Universities within the



network "I3PE"; it includes the whole concept, from the travel to and from Oradea, accommodation, lodging to social activities during the stay in Oradea.

The purpose of the I3PE Intensive Program 2012 is to improve the competence in promoting a sustainable society within the area of Physical Education, i.e. to promote an ethical, democratic and sustainable educational philosophy.

Moreover, it means to be able to discuss and reflect on national and European policies regarding the role of PE within the context of a sustainable society. The purpose is also to develop understanding of different cultures and

educational systems in order to gain new perspectives on one's own culture.

After the IP you will be able to:

- present your home country's educational system and compare and discuss educational systems in different countries;
- describe the basic concepts of national and European political ambitions and targets according to democracy and sustainability;
- describe the possible contribution of PE in promoting a sustainable society;



- reflect critically on school-related projects and evaluate various teaching methods that may contribute to a sustainable society.

The IP comprises Pre tasks, preparation of the IP, and Post IP tasks. During the stay in Oradea there will be daily lectures and work-shops, as well as group and individual studies. There will be also visits to Romanian schools to learn more about the

Romanian school system in general and Physical Education in particular.

In the beautiful landscape of the Carpathian Mountains it will be a 2 days trip to Stana de Vale and a visit to the Bears' Cave.

Felix Spa, resort with thermal water near Oradea, is another great location with very nice pools and forests which will be the place for other activities linked to the IP theme.



Social activities will finish the daily program after 6 p.m., so be prepared for long and intensive days.



**No fee is required for participating into the Program**. Food (breakfast, lunch and dinner), lodging, social activities, and study materials will be provided. For the travel costs, 75% will be paid within the program and 25<sup>th</sup> % will be paid by the student's home institution<sup>1</sup>. On your day off, you have to organize

your time by yourself and it will

be a chance to visit the city, to do some shopping in Oradea's Malls, relaxing, etc.



Lectures and workshops will be held in English. Please note that in order to provide food and lodging, our institution needs your preliminary application before 7<sup>th</sup> of September.
