Guidelines, requirements for abstract submission

- The abstract must be submitted as part of the registration process.
- All abstracts will be published in the proceedings of the International Student Conference on Sport Sciences (ISCSS).

- Abstracts are restricted to 3300 characters (including spaces but without title, authors and institutions), and may not contain tables or graphs. Abstracts will be printed exactly as they were submitted.
- The filename of the abstract should be as follows: Familyname_Firstname_2018.doc
- All abstracts will be judged and rated by two independent referees.
- Font: 12 point Times New Roman
- Line spacing: single
- Structure:
 - Authors' names
 - Institute, city, country
 - Supervisor's name and title
 - Title of Presentation
 - Introduction
 - Purpose of study
 - Hypothesis (if relevant)
 - Methods
 - Results
 - Conclusions
 - Keywords: maximum 5
